*Extracts from the Firearms Act 1968*

*'Section 21'*

*(1) A person who has been sentenced (to custody for life or) to preventive detention, or to imprisonment or to corrective training for a term of three years or more (or to youth custody (or detention in a young offender institution) for such a term), or who has been sentenced to be detained for such a term in a young offenders institution in Scotland, shall not at any time have a firearm or ammunition in his/her possession.*

*(2) A person who has been sentenced ..... to imprisonment for a term of three months or more but less than three years ( or to youth custody ( or detention in a young offender institution) for such a term), or who has been sentenced to be detained for such a term in a detention center or in a young offenders institution In Scotland, shall not at any time before the expiration of the period of five years from the date of his/her release have a firearm or ammunition in his/her possession.*
